HONEYDEW SAPS: CRIME BRIEF – 17 MAY 2016

HI-JACKING WARNING!!!

Motorists are urged to be very careful when arriving or leaving their residence. Be on the lookout for any suspicious person/s in the street or movement at your gate. Where possible ensure that you there is adequate light at your entrance and that there are no obstructions (big shrubs, trees etc.).

Hi-jackings have been reported on Malibongwe Drive, between the N1 and N14 highways. Ensure that your doors and windows are always closed and locked when approaching any intersections (stop street or robots).

As soon as you have entered your property immediately close and lock your gate before alighting from the vehicle. **DO NOT** leave the gate open while you are entering the house.

Theft out of motor vehicle:

Theft out of motor vehicle is still a problem and drivers are again urged **NOT** to leave **ANY** property inside the vehicle (this includes the boot). Vehicles are mostly targeted at **shopping centres** and **shopping malls**.

DO NOT leave your laptop in the boot of the vehicle when parking the vehicle; take it with you at all times. Always ensure that you lock your vehicle properly. Do not just press the remote and walk off. Stand next to your vehicle and ensure that it is properly locked before leaving the vehicle.

Vehicles are mostly targeted in the late afternoon rush between **15:30 and 18:30.**

Increase in Street Robberies:

Residents are kindly requested to inform their domestic workers and staff to be aware and vigilant when walking to and from work and also when waiting for transport.

We are experiencing an increase in street robberies, especially in the early morning hours and then late afternoons. Pedestrians are urged not to carry large sums of money in their bags. Also do not carry your cell phone in your hand. Place all your valuables out of sight.

Always be aware of your surroundings and do not make use of remote places or “short cuts” through greenbelt areas.

The **“HOT SPOT”** streets for robberies currently are: Peter Road, Johan Road, Glover Road, Beyers Naude Drive, Maple Drive, Olievenhout Avenue and Malibongwe Drive.
